The applicant must:

- 1. Be a holder of a PhD degree from a recognized University in the field applied or discipline.
- 2. Be at the level of least senior lecturer (for master's) and Associate professor (for PhD) and above at a recognized university.
- 3. Have a minimum of 5 years' experience at an institution of Higher Education in the relevant thematic field.
- 4. At least three years' working experience in a related industry/ organisation or world of practice.
- 5. Demonstrate experience in scientific research and publication in reputable refereed journals
- 6. Computer literate with demonstrable innovative pedagogical and adragogical approaches to course delivery
- 7. Experience. in Supervision of Masters and PhD research and thesis writing to completion
- 8. Candidates should be excellent in English/French language. Bilingual proficiency will be advantageous.

For PAUTRAIN Programmes:

- 1. Be holder of at least a master's degree in the specified subject or its recognised equivalent as the case may be from a recognized University.
- 2. Have proven professional competence in the African Union working languages in the right order of the combination (i.e., A, B and C) from among the following as applicable: Arabic, English, French, Kiswahili, Portuguese and Spanish. Knowledge and professional experience in any African community language should be indicated.
- 3. Specify the teaching subject from the list of courses advertised
- 4. Show evidence of at least Five-year experience of effective professional

- practice in the relevant languages and area.
- 5. Show evidence of at least Five years of teaching and practicing experience.
- 6. Show evidence of international experience.
- 7. Show interest and competence in pedagogy, scientific research and innovation.
- 8. Be proficient in the course language(s).
- 9. Demonstrate ability to work collaboratively with other colleagues.
- 10. Proficiency in French, English, Kiswahili, Arabic, Portuguese and Spanish (if different from instructional languages) will be an advantage.
- 11. A PhD in the relevant field and evidence of scientific research publications in the area of interest will be an added advantage.

Remuneration of Short-Term Lecturers

Courses are paid as per contact hours, at a rate of 70 USD per hour Additionally, visa costs, travel and subsistence allowances will be covered according to existing PAU-PAUGHSS guidelines.
